

BAG ROOTING

I just use a small plastic baggie, fold it into a small square and punch holes across the whole thing with a leather punch. The bag should resemble the plastic that's used for wrapping produce (lettuce).

Then use the bag the same as you would a rooting tube. Tape the top of the bag snugly around the the cutting and you're all set. Once the cutting is well rooted, you can either remove the bag or put up the whole thing.
